



Sounds

bang	to make a sudden very loud noise or noises, or to cause something to make it
blare	to make an unpleasantly loud noise
chime	to make a clear ringing sound
clang	to make a loud deep ringing sound like that of metal being hit, or to cause something to make this sound
clatter	to make continuous loud noises by hitting hard objects against each other, or to cause objects to do this
click	to make or cause something to make a short sharp sound
crackle	to make short sharp sounds like something that is burning in a fire
crash	to hit something, often making a loud noise or causing damage
creak	When a door, floorboard, etc. creaks, it makes a long low sound when it moves or is moved
crunch	to make a sound as if something is being crushed or broken
gasps	a quick deep breath, usually caused by a strong emotion
groan	a deep, long sound showing great pain or unhappiness; a complaining noise or phrase
hammer	to hit something hard many times, especially so that it makes a loud noise
hiss	to make a noise like a long sss sound
hoot	a short, loud, high sound; the sound an owl makes
howl	If a dog or wolf howls, it makes a long, sad sound; to make a loud sound, usually to express pain, sadness, or another strong emotion

plop	a short sound like that of a small object dropping into water
pound	to hit or beat repeatedly with a lot of force, or to crush something by hitting it repeatedly
ring out	when a sound rings out, it is loud and clear
roar	to make a long, loud, deep sound; if a vehicle or aircraft roars somewhere, it moves there very quickly making a lot of noise; to shout loudly
rumble	to make a continuous low sound
rustle	if things such as paper or leaves rustle, or if you rustle them, they move about and make a soft, dry sound
shriek	a short, loud, high cry, especially one produced suddenly as an expression of a powerful emotion
sizzle	to make a sound like food cooking in hot fat
slam	to shut, or to make something shut, with a lot of force, making a loud noise
squeak	to make a short, very high cry or sound
tap	to hit something gently, and often repeatedly, especially making short, sharp noises
thud	the sound that is made when something heavy falls or hits something else
toot	to make a short sound or series of short sounds, especially with the horn of a car as a warning
wail	to make a long, high cry, usually because of pain or sadness
