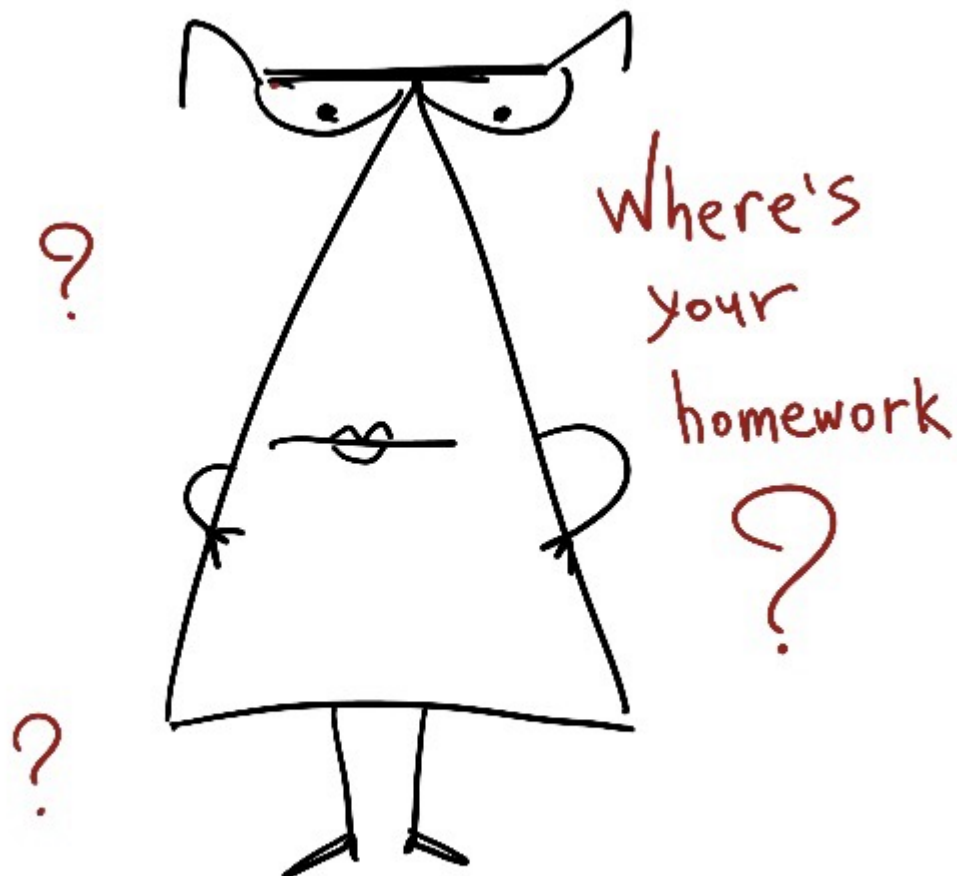
TASK 1

Imagine that you are a teacher at school. One of your students didn't hand in his homework and explained that his pet dog had eaten it. Write a note to your students' parents.

In your note:

- briefly explain the situation;
- express your doubts about the student's honesty;
- insist on the student bringing his homework within the next week.

Write about **50–60** words.



TASK 2

Imagine that you are a parent of the student from task 1. You really have a pet dog, and it did eat the notebook with the student's homework. Write a note to the teacher.

In your note:

- explain that the student wasn't lying;
- assure the teacher that the student will bring the rewritten homework.

Write about **60–70** words.
