Exercise 9

Write a **short story**.

Choose any subject, but use in your story **3 pairs of anagrammed words**.

*An anagram is the result of rearranging the letters of a word to produce a new word, using all the original letters exactly once. For example: "Joanna took the bottle and read: "Clean your **skin** before applying make-up". Then she put it on the edge of the **sink** and stared in the mirror". "Skin" and "sink" are a pair of anagrammed words. **Do not use this example** as your own pair of anagrams in your story.*

Write **150–250 words**.
